



# Simon Community NI Annual Report 2016 - 2017

Client Services - Between 2016 - 2017 we provided...


Accommodation for 2,391 people

The HOME Team helped **50** people move out of homelessness and into permanent accommodation. The HOME team is an NIHE & SCNI partnership




### **Floating Support**

We provided Floating Support to **80+ people** in the community who had experienced, or who were at risk of experiencing homelessness

#### Occupancy

96% of our beds were used last year



#### **Drug & Alcohol Addiction Services**

We have trained 16 support workers as drugs and alcohol addiction specialists



We have expanded our drug & alcohol outreach team and now have 5 outreach workers supporting 252 people
